**Self-Paced Courses (Tuition: \$0 – no tuition costs for self-paced courses for the 2017-2018 academic year)**

The Self-Paced Courses program provides priests and deacons with an extended time in which to complete the work in a course. The courses are not instructor-led and do not rely on interaction among participants (though interaction is possible among participants who are equally paced through the course). Courses can be started at any time, but all work must be completed within 8 weeks of enrollment in order to receive credit. Participants who successfully complete all the quizzes in each course will receive four (4) continuing education credits.
